The department offers two programmes, B.A Functional English and M.A English (since 2013-14). It also teaches Common Course (General English) to I and II year students, hence, in terms of workload it is the biggest department. The department also conducts Add-on certificate course in Spoken English. Despite shortage of permanent teaching staff the teachers have managed to complete not only the allotted portions of the syllabus but also publish internal mark lists on schedule up until February. In March regular classes were suspended due to Corona epidemic. Therefore, some programmes scheduled for the month of March had to be cancelled.

Programme Symbiosis: The department has initiated an attempt to integrate teaching learning process into a mutually enriching experience.
